### Inner Space

This is an image of Ros's Parkinsonian brain, with its depleted dopamine. Here again a certain amount of artistic licence has been used as the colours are artificial and introduced into the design in order to make the image easier for the medical staff to see. It is a panel that has lots of Ros's favourite pieces of old glass that she had been putting aside for years, awaiting the right moment for their use – and here they are, old purple round the edge and gold-pink on blue glass. The main body of the brain, as it were, is one sheet of old flashed blue on yellow glass – a collector's item piece that gives the appearance of having faded from dark blue to light. Within it are the flashed ruby on yellow pieces. The yellow bits within the blue are achieved by acid etching out the coat of blue.

At the bottom is Ros's signature - 'RG. 2000AD' - acided into blue glass, and the date the window was made. (Brain scans have the patient's name and date of scan on the bottom.) This signature includes Ros's trademark of a little crescent moon with a face.
